IX7511: Project Management for Business Administration - classic

IX7511 course approach

This course is a combination of:

- short presentations,
- labs run individually,
- case studies (by groups of two students),
- team works (by groups of four students),
- discussions.

For each topic addressed, the following three types of situations are reviewed:

- simple situations where common sense is key,
- intermediate situations where management of human aspects is essentials,
- complex situations where management of human aspects has to be supplemented with adequate tools and techniques.

This course is an opportunity for students to review cases, but also to create their own cases.
